Notes:

- The Certificate can be taken on a full-time or part-time basis. If part-time, the program must be completed within four years.
- Students are required to take a minimum of 1 course each Fall and Winter semester.
- At least 2 courses must be taken at the 2000/3000 level.
- Course selections must explore 3 religions, one of which must be Christianity.
- Students are required to be registered in consecutive academic years until completion, except for approved Leaves of Absence.
- No courses that are completed and counted toward the Certificate can be applied to another Emmanuel College or TST program.
