Master of Theological Studies: Theology, Spirituality and the Arts Stream Program Summary

8 courses in Level 1 and 12 courses for Level 2, for a total of 20 credits, with required Emmanuel College Core Courses, Designated Electives, and additional Electives for the Stream. Electives are designed to focus academic content in the area of theology, spirituality and the arts.

The degree may be completed purely on a part-time basis, and up to 8 years are allowed for completion.
